

A beautiful white or pink flower that blooms on trees in springtime, magnolia is fragrant and edible. It can be prepared as a pickle to dilute its strong flavor by adding vinegar, water, sugar, and salt.



Rosehips come in a variety of shapes and sizes—some round, some squat, some long—but they all share a pleasant, tart flavor. The fruit is very seedy, and the best part is the juicy red exterior.



The fruit of the strawberry tree looks like molten volcanic lava, with a spiky dark red exterior and a yellow-orange glow that seems to come from within. The fruit is sweet and lovely. It makes for good eating or excellent jam.



The unusual-looking fruit of the dogwood tree has a thick pink skin and a distinctive geometric shape. When you bite inside, though, you will taste nothing but a sweet yellow custard.
