Rosehips come in a variety of shapes and sizes—some round, some squat, some long—but they all share a pleasant, tart flavor. The fruit is very juicy and edible, and the best part is the seeds.




The fruit of the strawberry tree looks like molten volcanic lava, with a spiky dark red exterior and a yellow-orange interior. The fruit seems to come from within them. The fruit is sweet and juicy, but it makes for good eating or excellent jam.



The linden tree blooms just before the summer solstice, and its heavenly flowers can be collected, dried, and brewed as tea.



The unusual-loking fruit of the dogwood tree has a thick, pink skin and a distinctive geometric shape. When you bite inside, though, you will taste nothing but a sweet yellow custard.



Properly known as creeping raspberry, this plant is often found creeping underfoot, covering landscapes with its thick, dark green leaves. Watch for their golden berries in summertime!
